Weekly Awards

Each week in our Friday Worship, we award a range of certificates and prizes, for example: Child of the week, House Team Points Cup, Attendance Cup, Times Tables Champions etc - all of which are enthusiastically received.

As a Church school, we will also be presenting our Christian Values Award, in the form of a small cross that can be worn on the collar / lapel of a polo shirt. This award will be given to children who have demonstrated in how they behave the particular Christian Value we are focusing on in school in each particular term. This term our value is 'Hope' and will be exploring what this means and how we can demonstrate it in our everyday lives.



This year we will also be introducing an 'Always Friday' where one child from each class, who has shown they are 'Kind, Respectful and Ready', will be invited to have a hot chocolate with the Headteacher.

Breakfast Club

Our Breakfast Club runs every morning from 8.00am and still proves excellent value for money at £3.05 a session. This has to be booked via Parent Pay. Flu Immunisation

All children from Reception through to Year 6 will be given the opportunity to have the flu immunisation in the form of a nasal spray. This is due to happen on Monday 5th October.



Please return your permission forms that will be sent out in the next few days - this year, more than any other year, it is important that our children and consequently the whole Hill Top community are as protected as they possibly can be from seasonal flus.

Free School Meals

Whilst we know that all children in Reception and Key Stage 1 are entitled to a free school meal - this is known as the Universal Free School Meal offer - it is very important that they, as well as the parents of any Key Stage 2 children, still register via the <u>Bradford Council Website</u>

if you receive:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, provided they are not receiving Working Tax Credit
- the 'Guaranteed' element of the State Pension Credit
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (you will need to apply directly to the school or call the Education Service on 01274 439393)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income threshold of less than $\pounds7,400$

<u>If you do have entitlement to a free school meal, we can offer you a voucher</u> <u>code towards the purchase of a Hill Top winter coat, fleece or uniform.</u>
